Dear Erika,

The City received a Public Records Request from you on February 27, 2023 for the following:

"I would like to find out if the city has kept copies of letters I've written to Mayors. I have written to Mayors going back to 2014 - sent both via mail and via electronic form. I have probably sent around half a dozen letters to Portland Mayors, beginning with Mayor Hales in 2014."

The requested records are attached or available online at the Portland Public Records Request Center by going to "My Public Records Request Center" - "View My Requests" - and clicking the button "View Files."

Please note, if you have been provided with emails or text messages as a part of your request, they may have been converted to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT). Additionally, please note that if your search is pulling emails from an email distribution list, only current employees in that list will be included. Email distribution lists do not contain emails of departed employees.

The City now considers your request fulfilled and it will be closed. Please note, messages sent on closed requests will not be monitored.

Thank you. I see you closed my request. Although these are not ALL the communications I've sent, I'm very glad that you've kept some of them. What is of more concern, and why I'm responding, is that I NEVER received the first email in this list - the one that was supposedly sent at 9:59pm on October 28, 2014. I've never seen this email before today, and I've just done a search through my Gmail account - the same account as I had back then - and it's nowhere to be found. I never received it.

Unfortunately this isn't the first time important emails have vaporized.

What would be really helpful to me is if I could access my police records - all of them. I am low income and the costs associated with FOIA requests are prohibitive to me.

Being as I've suffered now for going on 10 years, including from a defamation campaign that's involved a number of people calling police with false reports about me, and police making claims about me to others where I have no idea how they originated - can we work something out where I am able to receive my own records from police free of charge?

Thank you for any help you can offer.
